Shortages of raw materials



As we indicated in our previous newsletter (April), we are facing a **shortage of raw materials** since the end of 2020. **This shortage now affects all our products**: plastic, latex, wood, metal, cotton. It is true that the petrochemical industry in Texas has been hit hard by the severe cold weather that hit at the end of 2020 - beginning of 2021 and damaged many plants. But we are facing a global and long term speculative movement, as are all our colleagues.

Our extremely low margins will not allow us to support these strong increases, in addition to the problem of maritime transport but also the additional costs related to the COVID-19.

We therefore invite you to **maximize your next orders** because a change in tariffs will unfortunately be expected in the second half of 2021. We are working with all our raw materials suppliers, including in the redefinition of our packaging to reduce the impact of these increases but we have to inform you of the problem now.



We have decided to **financially support India** in its fight against the Covid-19 (supply of medical material and especially oxygen, in particular at in the Capital, Delhi, confronted with a humanitarian disaster). This decision follows the **support we had given to Lebanon following the explosion of the Port of Beirut** on August 4, 2020. Even if our help is minimal since we are an SME, we consider that **our role as an entrepreneur is also social and human**.

Next meeting in June to present, among other things, the development of a new market, our human reinforcement in Africa, and the support we provide to an association.
